No new Steppingstones on LOCF Common Area Property are allowed. Steppingstones in place before August 31, 2021 are Grandfathered in by the Board of Directors with the following guidelines:

- Only Steppingstones grandfathered in are approved by the BOD and all others will be removed by the BOD at the homeowner's expense.
- Stepstones must be made from a natural stone or material and natural in color that will blend into the environment.
- Steppingstones are only allowed from a homeowner's back gate onto LOCF Common area property to the nearest sidewalk. Steppingstones must look professionally installed or can be removed without notice to the homeowner at the homeowner's expense.
- Steppingstones must be flat to the ground to allow mowers to move over them. If steppingstones are creating a problem for the landscape company to do their job to take care of the common area, they will be removed without homeowner notice.
- Homeowners must keep steppingstones in good repair, clean, attractive, and sanitary condition consistent with the Community-Wide standard or can be removed without notice to the homeowner at the homeowner's expense.
